

Rye (R) Tootgarook (T) & St Andrews (S), Post Code 3941, Street Names

Delineation of Postcode **3941** as per Melways, going anti-clockwise from Rye, is:

West along Point Nepean Rd; then south along Canterbury Jetty Rd to the coast;
 South-east along the coast to encompass St Andrews Beach (3941);
 East, then north-west and north along the St Andrews Beach golf club (in Fingal) boundary;
 West-north-west along Sandy Road (continues to skirt around adjoining FINGAL 3939);
 North to cross the Browns Rd/Weeroona St junction (continues approx 200m along Weeroona St);
 East along proposed freeway alignment to join Truemans Rd near northern boundary council tip;
 Generally north-north-east along Truemans Rd, past Tootgarook (3941) to join Point Nepean Rd;
 Finally, west along Point Nepean Rd past Tootgarook (3941) back to Rye (3941).

Primary sources were Google Maps and Melways (Melways references are now included)
